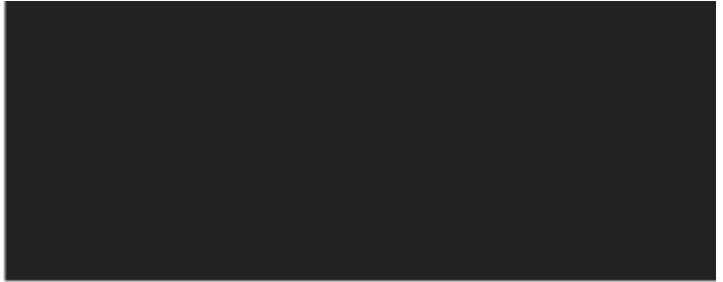

Ballot Title:

Should the current State Flag be adopted by constitutional amendment?

Ballot Summary:

Initiative Measure No. 62 proposes to amend the Mississippi Constitution to establish the 1894 flag as the one official State Flag for the State of Mississippi, and require that the flag be flown at the principal installations of all State supported institutions, State agencies and political subdivisions.

Text of Initiative Measure Number 62:

The Mississippi Constitution shall be amended to state: The 1894 State Flag of Mississippi is the one official State Flag for the State of Mississippi, and it shall be flown at the principal installations of all State supported institutions, State agencies, and political subdivisions. Any proposed amendment or proposed changes to the State Flag of Mississippi shall conform to the provisions of Section 273 Amendment Process of the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, as amended, as proposed by the Legislature or by initiative of the people.

Source of revenue required to implement the initiative:

This measure, if adopted, will not have any effect on government revenue or require a reallocation of / from currently-funded programs.
